

# Chenille Letter Key Ring



Create this textured monogram key ring to add a personal touch to many of your accessories such as handbags, backpacks, computer bags, carry-on luggage, and more. This project includes all 26 letters from the alphabet, so you can simply select the letters you want. The finished size of one key ring is approximately 2½" x 4" (6cm x 10cm).

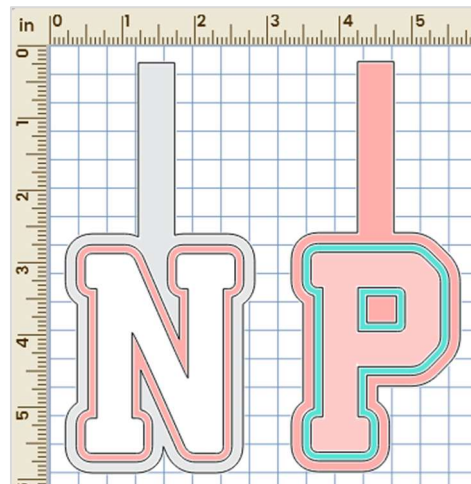
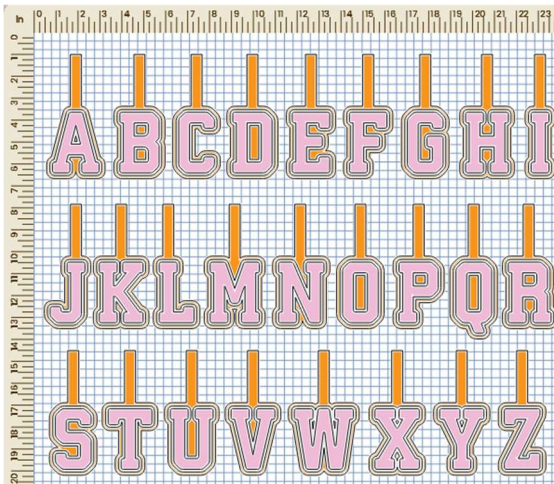
## What you need


- Microfiber Cloth
- Glitter Felt Sheet
- Faux Leather
- Paper-backed Fusible Web
- Fabric Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Standard Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Rotary Blade
- Brayer
- Iron and Ironing Board or Heat Press
- Sewing Machine

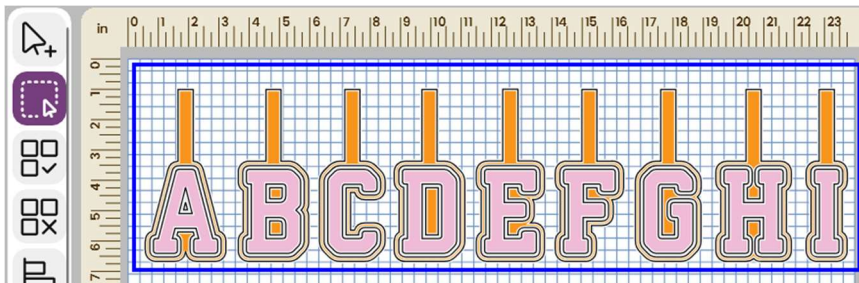
- Thread to match color of the Microfiber Cloth
- Lint Roller
- All Purpose Glue
- Key Ring

## Directions

1. Follow the manufacturer’s instructions to apply the paper-backed fusible web to the back of the microfiber cloth using an iron or a heat press.
2. Open the project in Canvas. The alphabet from A to Z is included in the project. Save the original file to your device or in Vault if you only want to make a few selected letters now.
3. Select All then Ungroup. Remove the letters you do not want to make (using the Cut or Delete icons) and leave the ones you *do* want to use on the Canvas. Change colors if desired. Save the new file with a new name (File – Save As).



PRO-TIP: Use the 'Box Select'  icon to select many letters at the same time. Click the upper left corner of the area you would like to select then hold and drag the mouse to the opposite corner of the desired letters.



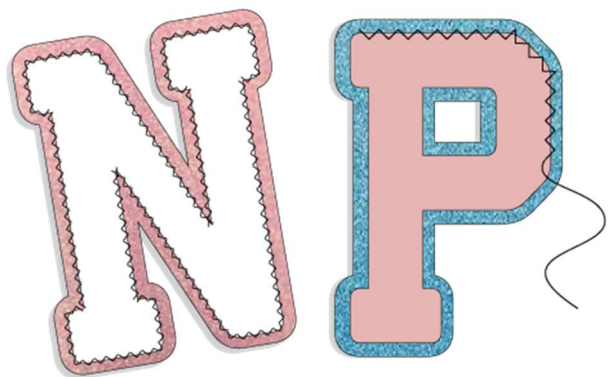
4. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the faux leather on your Standard Grip Mat and follow the steps to cut the material on your crafting machine.

*Note: When using more than one material, check all settings and customize inputs for your mat size, material type, material size, and arrangement of pieces before selecting next to begin cutting each layer.*

5. Place the glitter felt on your 12" x 12" Fabric Grip Mat. Use a Brayer to help adhere the felt to the cutting mat. Follow the steps to cut the felt on your crafting machine.
6. Remove the paper backing and place the microfiber cloth, fusible web side down on the fabric grip mat. Use a Brayer to help adhere the material to the cutting mat, eliminating wrinkles or bubbles. Follow the steps to cut the cloth on your crafting machine. The microfiber cloth may fray. The thinner and denser your cloth is, the better the results. Be careful when removing the material from the mat.
7. Use your iron or heat press to fuse the microfiber letters to the glitter felt. You might need the lint roller to remove fuzz.



8. Set your sewing machine to a narrow zigzag stitch and sew around the edges of the letter.



9. Thread the keyring onto the strap and fold it to the back. Set your sewing machine for straight stitch and sew across to secure.



10. Add glue to the back of the felt letter and place it on the faux leather base. Let it dry completely before you add your keys or attach it to your bag.
