

Holiday Tree Ornaments



Fabric tree ornaments decorated with a bell on the top and a natural twig stem are a fun way to add charm to your holiday décor. You can personalize with heat transfer vinyl designs if desired. The cut file and the material listed is for making three trees. The finished size of one tree (without the string) is approximately 6" (15 cm).

What you need


- Fabric 20" x 10" (50 cm x 25 cm)
- Heat Transfer Vinyl Gold
- Fabric Grip Mat 12" x 24"
- Standard Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- SINGER® momento™ Heat Removable Fabric Pen
- Rotary Blade
- Basic Blade
- Brayer

- Weeding Tool
- Sewing Machine
- Thread
- Hand Sewing Needle
- Heat Press
- Parchment Paper
- Chopstick
- Scissors
- Hot Glue Gun
- Fiber Fill
- 3 Natural Twig Sticks 4" (10 cm) long
- String for hanging 1 yd (90cm)
- Ribbon 16" (40cm) long
- 3 Bells for Crafts


Directions

1. Open the project in Canvas. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the fabric with the right side facing down onto the Fabric Grip Mat. Use a Brayer to help adhere the material to the cutting mat. Place the Heat Removable Fabric Pen in the left carriage and the Rotary Blade in the right. Follow the steps to draw and cut the fabric on your crafting machine.


Note: When using more than one material, check all settings and customize inputs for your mat size, material type, material size, and arrangement of pieces before selecting next to begin cutting each layer.




- 2. Place the heat transfer vinyl on the Standard Grip Mat. Change to the basic blade and follow the steps to cut vinyl on your crafting machine. Weed the vinyl and set aside for now.
- 3. Place two triangles right sides together. Set your sewing machine for straight stitch and sew around the tree shape using 3/8" (1 cm) seam allowance and the pen lines as guides. Leave a 2" (5 cm) opening at the bottom to turn the right side out. Backstitch at beginning and end.
- Snip the corners and trim the seam allowance to reduce bulk. Make sure you don't cut the seam.



- 5. Turn the right side out. Use a chopstick to push out the corners.
- 6. Fold the bottom seam allowance to the inside and press.
- 7. Position the vinyl design on the tree, cover with parchment paper and use the heat press to apply.



- 8. Fill the tree with fiber fill.
- 9. Put the twig into the opening in the tree. Use the hot glue gun to glue the twig in place and close the opening.



- 10. Cut the string into 12" (30 cm) long pieces. Thread a string through the loop in a bell and tie the string ends together to form a hanging loop.
- 11. Cut the ribbon into 5" (13 cm) long pieces and fold in half. Use a hand sewing needle and thread to attach the ribbon and the bell at the top of the tree.
