

## **Heart Petal Box**



This lovely little gift box can be used as a way to package a small gift, or be given as a gift all by itself! There are two small windows that offer a little peek at what's inside. The finished size of the box is approximately  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.5 cm x 6.5 cm x 9 cm).


## What you need

- Medium Cardstock (Light Pink)
- Light Cardstock (Pink)
- Clear Plastic (for example, plastic binder sleeve, for the "windows")
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Dual Tip Marker
- Fine Debossing Tool
- Adhesive
- Double-sided Tape (optional)


## **Directions**

- 1. Open the project in Canvas.
- Go to the Output Menu and click Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your mat and follow the steps to score, draw and cut the material on your crafting machine.

Note: Scoring (using the Fine Debossing Tool) on the wrong side of your project makes it easier to fold. Place the material on your mat with the wrong side facing up.




- 3. Fold in the lids and flaps on the scored fold lines. Flatten the box out again. Fold in the glue tab and each side on the vertical fold lines, then flatten the box.
- 4. Cut two squares of clear plastic 2¼" x 2¼" (5.5 cm x 5.5 cm). Glue them to the wrong side of the box to cover the heart-shaped windows.



5. Use the pen or a marker to color in the outline of the phrases.

6. Glue the elements to the box shape.



- 7. Put glue down the entire length of the glue tab. Shape the sides into a box shape and glue the tab to the inside of the last side. You can use double-sided tape in place of the glue, if desired.
- 8. Fold the bottom flaps in and close the bottom lid over them. Tuck the bottom lid's flap inside the box. Glue the bottom flaps to the box's bottom.
- 9. To close the top, fold each petal over, and behind the previous petal, in counter-clockwise sequence. Push down in the center to secure the top.
