

Envelope for Pattern



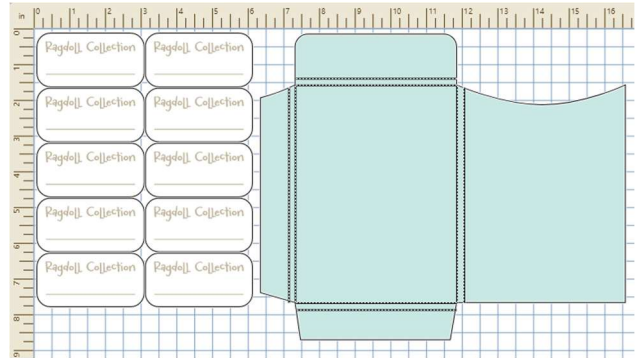
A practical envelope for organizing and storing your sewing patterns, perfect for keeping all your projects in order. The envelopes are cut using MOMENTO™, providing a precise and clean finish. Make Print and Cut labels for easy identification of each pattern. This solution makes it both simple and efficient to keep your sewing projects organized and easily accessible. Finished size of the envelope is approximately 4 ½" x 6" (11 cm x 15 cm).

What you need

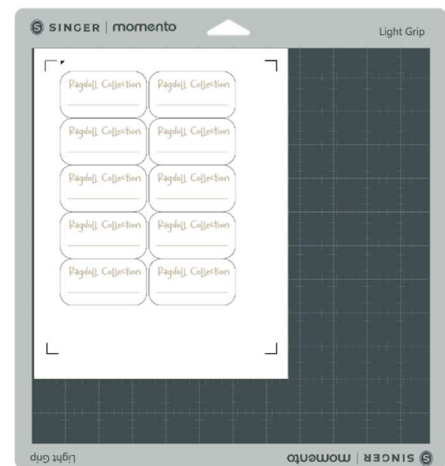
- Medium Cardstock 12" x 12" (30 cm x 30 cm)
- Printable Sticker Paper
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Debossing Tool (for scoring)
- Brayer
- Scraping Tool
- Paper Adhesive

Directions

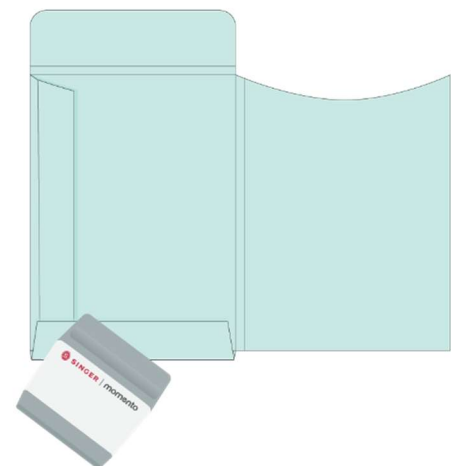
1. **Print the Labels.** Open the project in Canvas. Go to the Output menu and select Send to Machine. Prepare your project by selecting the Mat Size and Material. Ensure the material size matches your printable sticker paper (Letter or A4). Click "Print." Choose your printer and set the paper size, color, etc. Then, print the labels.



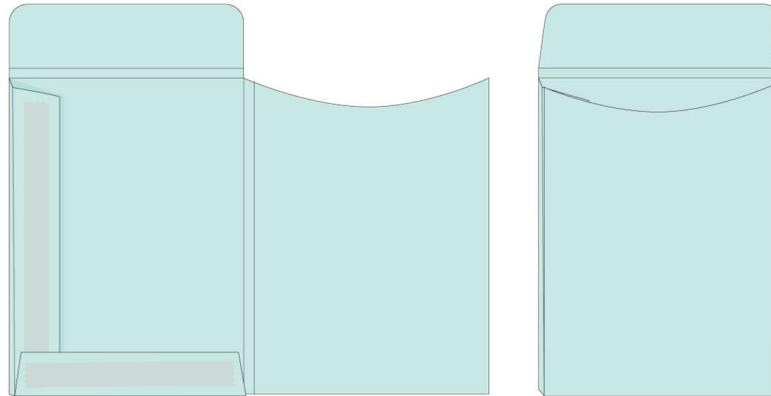
2. **Cut the Labels.** Place the printed sticker paper on the mat, aligning the edges in the top left corner. With the basic blade in the right carriage, follow the on-screen steps to cut the labels on your craft cutting machine.



3. **Cut the Envelope.** Place the cardstock on the mat and insert debossing tool into the right carriage. Change the inputs for mat size, material type and material size. Follow the on-screen steps to score the folding lines. Once done, switch to the basic blade and follow the steps to cut the envelope.
4. **Fold the Envelope.** Gently remove the cardstock from the mat. Fold along the scored lines. Use the scraper tool to sharpen the folds.



5. **Assemble the Envelope.** Apply glue to the side and bottom panels of the envelope. Fold the front flap over and press it into place.



6. **Complete the Envelope.** Attach a sticker label to the envelope.
