

Easter Animal Ornaments



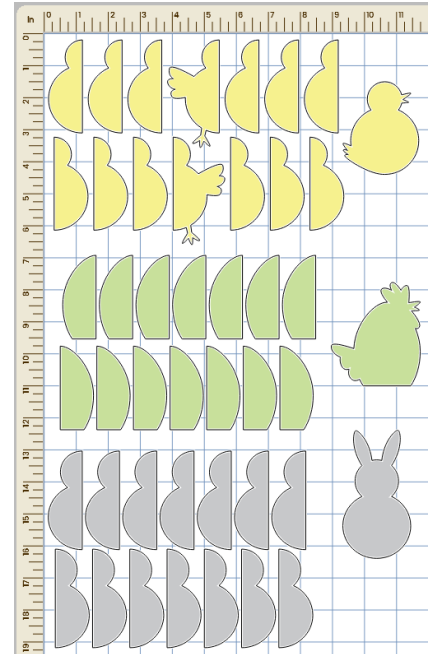
Make cute paper ornaments to decorate for Easter. Make several to display on small branches as a table centerpiece. The finished size of the ornaments is approximately 2¾" x 2¾" x 4" (7cm x 7cm x 10cm).

What you need

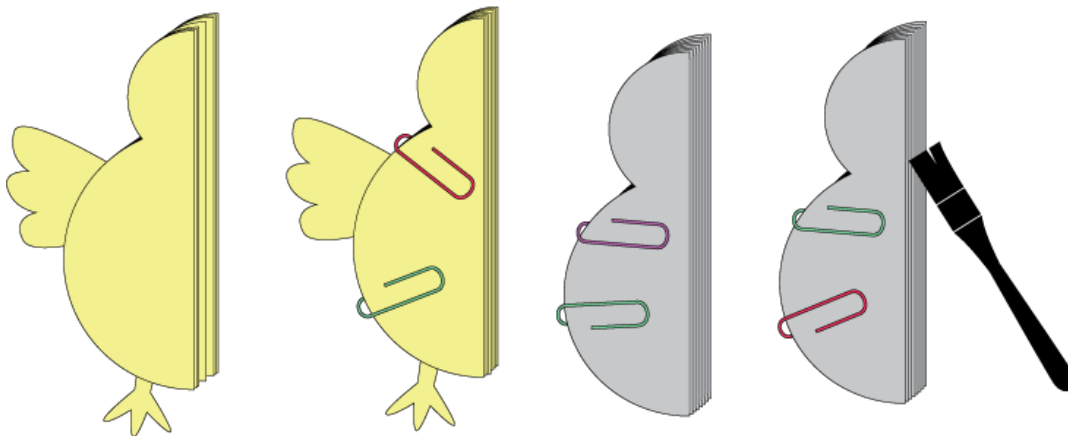
- Light Cardstock (Yellow)
- Light Cardstock (Green)
- Light Cardstock (Gray)
- String - 9" (23cm) for each
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Book Binder's Glue
- Paper Clips

Directions

1. Open the project in Canvas.
2. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your mat and follow the steps to cut the material on your crafting machine.
3. Gently remove the paper pieces from the mat. Repeat the cut for the desired number of ornaments.



4. Cut pieces of string, approximately 9" (23cm) long.
5. For the Chicken: Place three identical pieces (without wings) on top of each other, then add one with wings, then three without (for a total of seven). Use a paperclip to hold the pieces together. Do the same with another set.
6. For the Hen and the Bunny: Line up seven pieces in each bundle and hold them in place with a paperclip.
7. Spread book binding glue on the straight edge to glue together. Let it dry. Book binding glue remains soft and flexible as it dries.



8. Spread the shapes open and glue to each side of the centerpiece. Add the string in the center. Press together and let them dry.
