

Carrot Treat Box



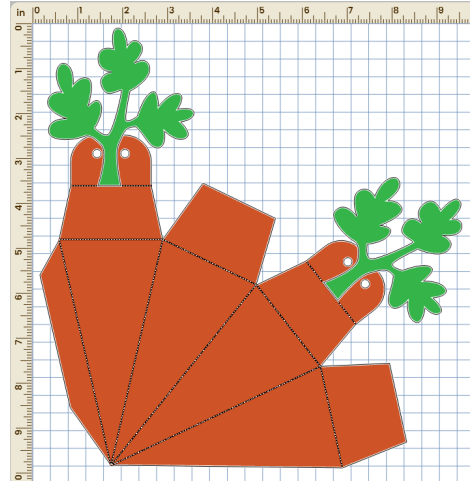
Make cute paper carrot boxes and fill with treats to give away at Easter. Give them as gifts or use them simply as table decor. The finished size of one carrot box is approximately 2¾" x 8 x 1⅛" (7cm x 20cm x 3cm).

What you need

- Medium Cardstock (Orange)
- Medium Cardstock (Green)
- ½" (13mm) Satin Ribbon, 12" (30cm) for each
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Scraper
- Fine Debossing Tip (for scoring)
- Adhesive

Directions

1. Open the project in Canvas.
2. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your mat and follow the steps to score and cut the material on your crafting machine.



3. Fold along the scoring lines.
4. Glue the stem piece to the carrot between the holes on the outside of the box, as shown.
5. Glue the tab on the left side to the underside of the right edge to form the cone shape.
6. Cut a piece of ribbon, approximately 12" (30cm) long. Fill the cone with candy or treats and thread the ribbon through the holes. Make a neat bow and trim the ends diagonally.
