

Paper Poinsettia



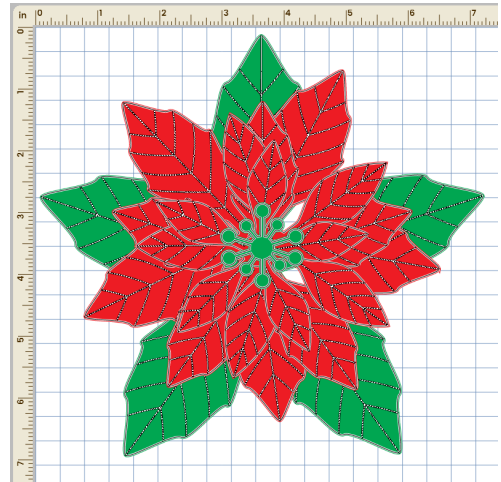
Enjoy the beauty of poinsettia flowers all year long! Make them in ivory, or in the more traditional red color – the choice is yours. Create one, or make a full bouquet. The finished size of one poinsettia is approximately 7" x 7" (18cm x 18cm).

What you need

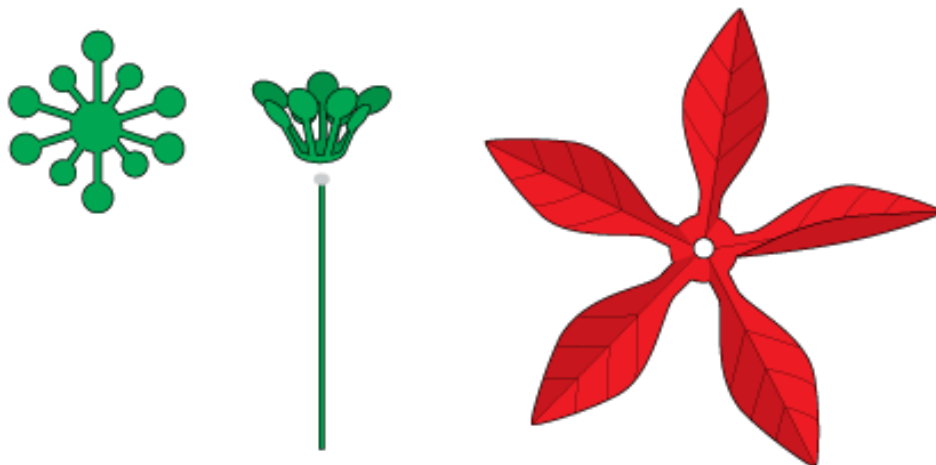
- Medium Cardstock (Dark Green)
- Medium Cardstock (Ivory or Red)
- Florist Paper-wrapped Wire 20 gauge
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tip (for scoring)
- Scoring Stylus (for manual shaping of stamen)
- Hot Glue Gun

Directions

1. Open the project in Canvas.
2. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your mat and follow the steps to score and cut the material on your crafting machine. Make sure to select 'Rearrange to reduce waste' and arrange to your material size..



3. Use the Scoring Stylus to shape the stamen.
4. Fold and shape the petals and leaves along the middle score lines.
5. Cut a piece of Florist Paper-wrapped Wire minimum 3" (7.5 cm) long or longer if you want to place it in a vase. Use the hot glue gun and attach the stamen to the top of the wire.



- Starting with the smallest petal shape, insert to the wire and glue in place. Insert the following layers and glue in place with a distance of approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ " to $\frac{1}{2}$ " (6mm to 12mm) layer, ending with the green leaves.
