

Gift Card Holder




Sometimes you just can't think of "the perfect gift", so a gift card can often be the solution. Why not create a unique way to present your gift card by making this special card holder? The holder features a three-dimensional bow along with a "Merry Christmas" greeting. The finished size is approximately 4" x 4" (10cm x 10cm).

What you need


- Medium Cardstock (Red)
- Medium Cardstock (White)
- Medium Cardstock (Gray)
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tip (for scoring)
- Dual Tip Marker
- Adhesive
- Double-sided Tape

Directions

- 1. Open the project in Canvas.
- Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your mat and follow the steps to score, draw and cut the material on your crafting machine. Rearrange to reduce waste.



- 3. Fold the pieces along the scoring lines.
- 4. Put adhesive on the inside of the top red piece. Put the white card holder in place and press down.
- 5. Put adhesive on the side panels and glue the pocket together.




- 6. To make the bow, fold the side tabs into the center and secure using strong double-sided tape or hot glue.
- 7. Assemble the bow to the bow tails base using a little glue or more double-sided tape.

8. Take the small rectangle and wrap it around the center of your bow. Secure using some more glue or tape to finish.



9. Glue the "ribbon" pieces in place. Attach the bow and the label.
