

New Year's Glitter Earrings



Add some bling to your New Year's Eve party ensemble with these sparkly earrings, made using glitter iron-on vinyl. The finished size is approximately 3" x 3" (7.5cm x 7.5cm).

What you need

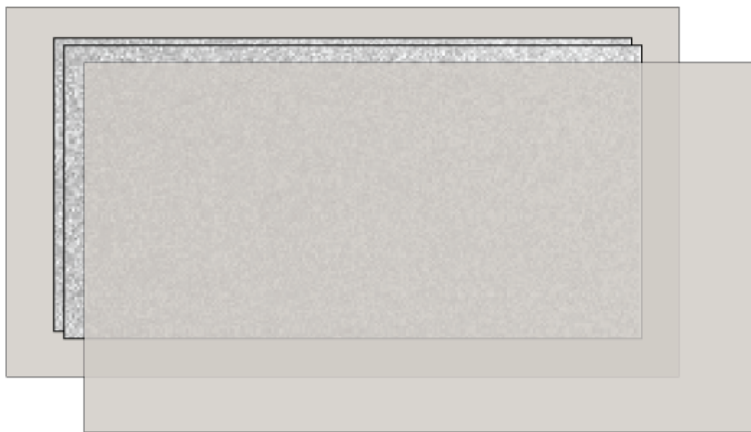
- Glitter Heat Transfer Vinyl
- Earring Hooks and Jump Rings
- Strong Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Brayer
- Heat Press
- Parchment or Butcher Paper
- Heat Resistant Tape (optional)
- Painter's Tape

Directions

1. To make the double sided glitter vinyl material: Cut two pieces of Glitter Heat Transfer Vinyl approximately 8" x 4" (20cm x 10cm).
2. Place the two pieces, vinyl (dull) sides together. If you are unsure which is the dull side, peel back a corner of your **HTV**, and the colored side is your vinyl. The clear side is the adhesive liner. To help the two pieces of vinyl stay together during the heat press process you can use heat resistant tape.

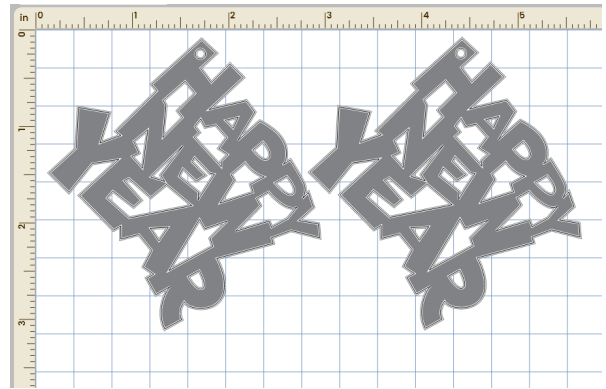


3. Sandwich the vinyl between two pieces of Parchment or Butcher Paper, larger than the vinyl to protect your Heat Press and pressing mat. Use your Heat Press to fuse the vinyl layers together.



4. Peel off the clear liner on both sides of the fused glitter vinyl.

5. Open the project in Canvas. Place the vinyl on your mat. Use a Brayer to help adhere the material to the cutting mat, eliminating wrinkles or bubbles. Tape all four sides of the material down to the mat using painter's tape.



6. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Follow the steps to cut the material on your crafting machine.

Note: As we have created a material that is not on the material list, you have to increase the pressure. Make a test cut to ensure that it will cut through double layers.

7. To assemble the earrings, attach the earring hook rings to the holes in the cut vinyl triangles.
8. Attach the earring fish hooks to the rings.
