

Pop-Up Christmas Tree Card



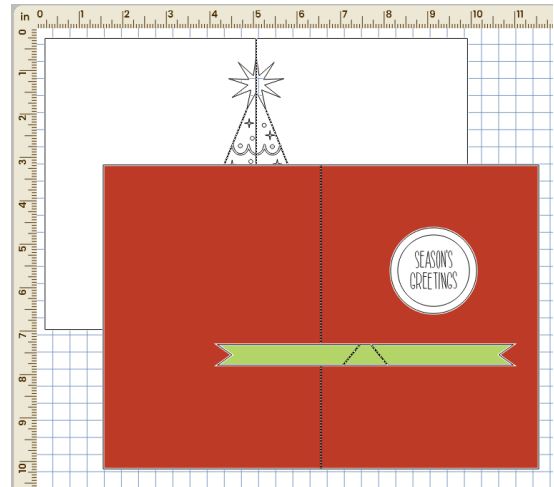
Who doesn't love the unexpected surprise provided when receiving a pop-up card? The card front features a simple greeting and three-dimensional ribbon embellishment, while inside awaits a decorated tree. The finished size is approximately 5" x 7" (13cm x 18cm).

What you need

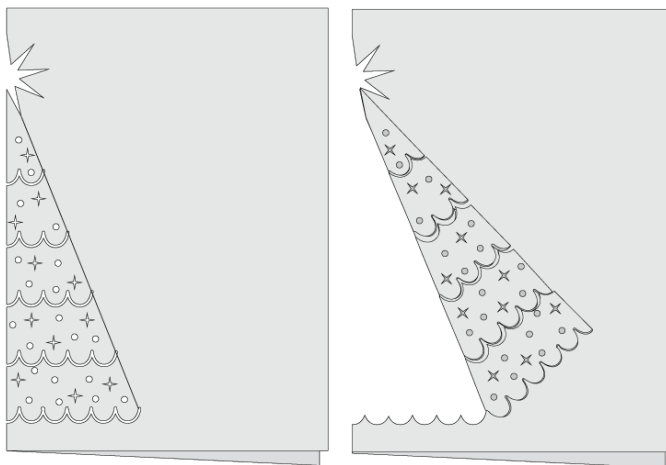
- Medium Cardstock (Red)
- Medium Cardstock (White)
- Cardstock (Green)
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tip (for scoring)
- Dual Tip Pen
- Scraper
- Adhesive

Directions

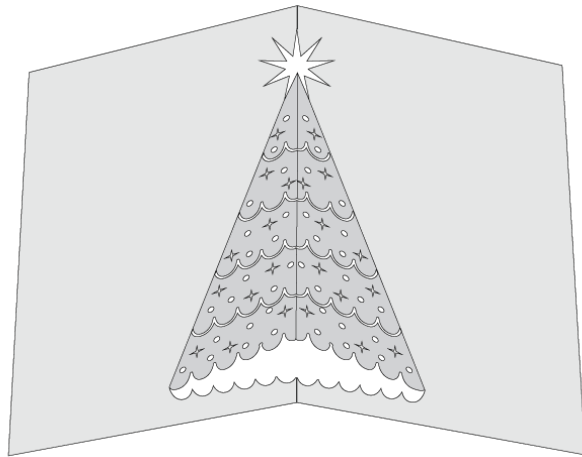
1. Open the project in Canvas.
2. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Select rearrange to reduce waste to ensure space on your cardstock. Place the cardstock on your mat and follow the steps to score, draw and cut the cardstock on your crafting machine.



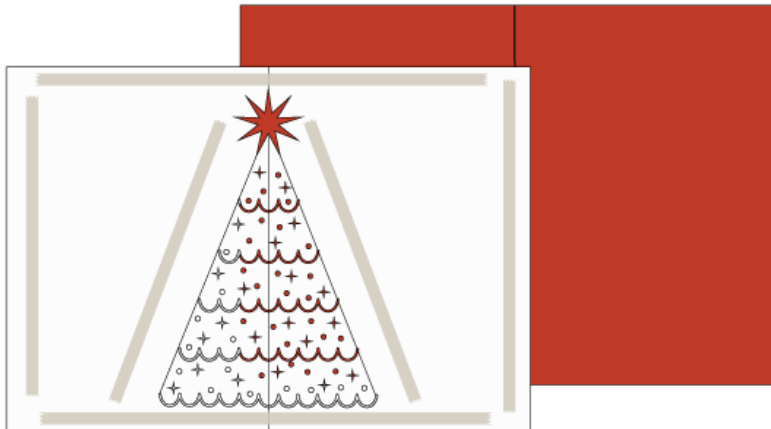
3. Fold the outer red card along the scoring line.
4. Fold the white card completely in half along the scoring line.
5. Fold each of the Christmas tree segments back against the card along the scoring lines and crease with your finger or Scraper.



- Put each segment back in its original position. Then, open the card like a tent and push the segments through to the other side. Turn over to pop them out even more.



- Apply adhesive around the edges and around the tree shape. Position it on the red card cover. Close the card, flattening it completely.



- Fold the green ribbon at the scoring lines. Glue the ribbon and the label in place.
