

Winter Pillow Cushion



This decorative pillow cushion will be a great addition to your holiday decor. Use a purchased pillow, or make one yourself. You can adjust the size of the text to fit whatever pillow size you want. The finished size of the pillow shown is approximately 20° x 20° (50cm x 50cm).

What you need

- Cushion Cover 20" x 20" (50cm x 50cm)
- Heat Transfer Vinyl (Black)
- Heat Transfer Vinyl (White)
- Standard Grip Mat 12" x 24"
- Basic Blade
- Heat Press
- Weeding Tool
- Scissors
- Parchment or Butcher Paper
- Lint Roller

Directions

- 1. Pre-wash the cushion cover to pre-shrink the fabric, as well as to remove any chemical residue that may have been added by the manufacturer for shipping. This will also help ensure that your vinyl will adhere to the fabric properly.
- 2. Open the project in Canvas.
- Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the Heat Transfer Vinyl, shiny side down (clear liner) on your Standard Grip Mat. Follow the steps to cut the vinyl on your crafting machine. Remember to Flip for Reverse Cutting.

To save vinyl, Rearrange to reduce waste. Separate the Snowflake designs by cutting the clear liner with a pair of scissors. Separate the Text rows the same way.



- 4. Use a Weeding Tool to remove unwanted iron-on pieces, leaving the design on the clear liner.
- 5. Use a lint roller to clean any stray lint or fuzz from the area of your pillow where you plan to adhere the vinyl.
- 6. Position the Snowflakes on the pillow cover.
- 7. Use your Heat Press to apply the vinyl to your pillow. Because we are layering the iron-on vinyl, we have to press the bottom layer for less time to avoid overheating the design. Peel off the clear transfer sheet.

8. Place the second layer (black text) over the bottom layer. Cover the whole design with a piece of parchment or butcher paper, as you do not want any vinyl to touch your heat press or iron. Press then peel off the transfer sheet.
