## Hair Clip Bow



Whether it's for a party, special occasion, or just to feel dressed up, a simple hair clip bow might be all you need to finish your look. These bows are made with faux suede, giving them a sophisticated vibe. The finished size of the bow is approximately $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{8} \mathbf{"}^{\prime \prime}(9 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ 3 cm ).

## What you need

- Hair Clip
- Faux Suede 6" x $4^{\prime \prime}$ ( $15.25 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
- Fabric Grip Mat $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$
- Rotary Blade
- Brayer
- Hot Glue Gun


## Directions

1. Open the project in Canvas.
2. Place the suede (with the right side facing you) on your mat. Use a Brayer to help adhere the material to the cutting mat.
3. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Follow the steps to cut the material on your crafting machine.

4. To make the double bow, fold the side tabs into the center and secure using a hot glue gun. Do the same with both bow pieces.
5. Assemble your bow by taking the larger bow piece you've just made and securing it to the bow tails base using a small amount of glue. Then, add the smaller bow and adhere it to the top.

6. Take the last piece (the small rectangle) and wrap it around the center of your bow. Secure using some more glue to finish.
7. Glue the bow to the hair clip and let it dry thoroughly.
