

Paper Rose



Make this paper rose and save yourself a trip to the florist shop! It has a beautiful shape that will make you think it could almost be real! Create several for a full bouquet. Add a customized heart-shaped tag, if desired. The finished size is approximately 2" x 7" (5cm x 18cm).

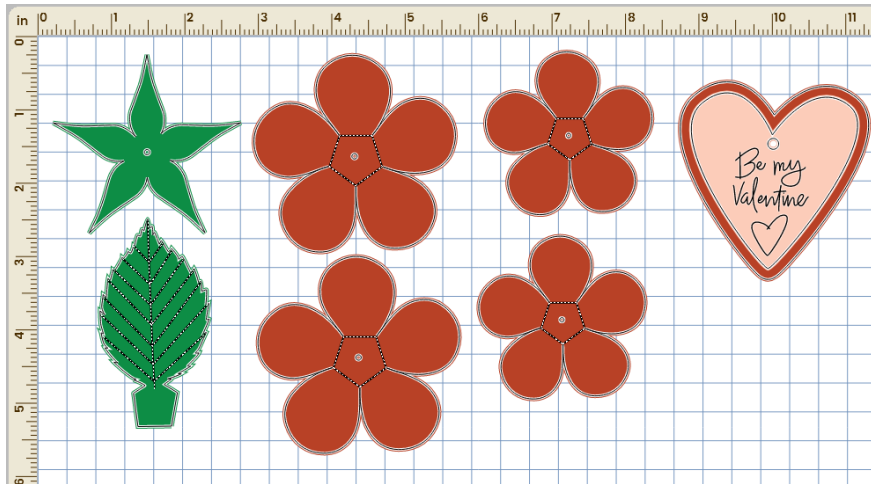
What you need

- Light Cardstock (Red)
- Light Cardstock (Green)
- Light Cardstock (Pink)
- Paper-Wrapped Florist Wire (20 gauge)
- Floral Tape
- Satin Ribbon 1/8" (3mm) wide
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tip (for scoring)
- Dual Tip Marker (thin side)

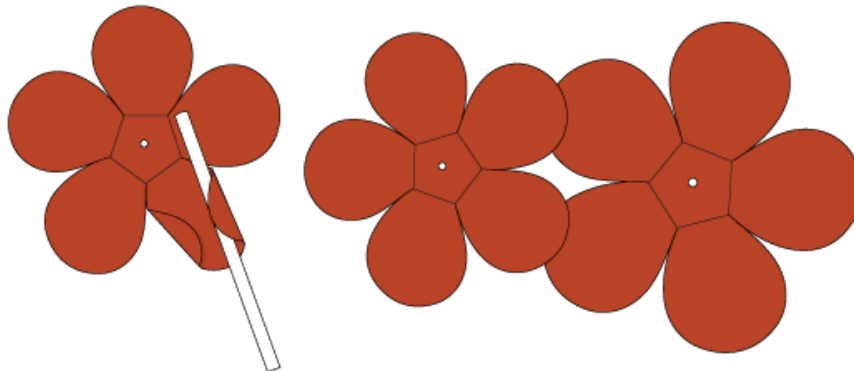
- Narrow Wooden Dowel, or similar (for curling petals)
- Hot Glue Gun

Directions

1. Open the project in Canvas. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Follow the steps to score, draw and cut the paper on your crafting machine.

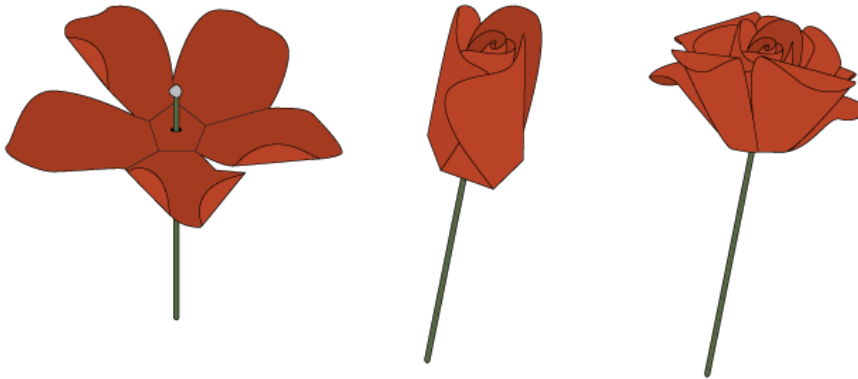


2. Remove the flower pieces from the mat by gently bending and pulling the mat from the cardstock.
3. Use a narrow wooden dowel (or similar) to "curl" each petal.

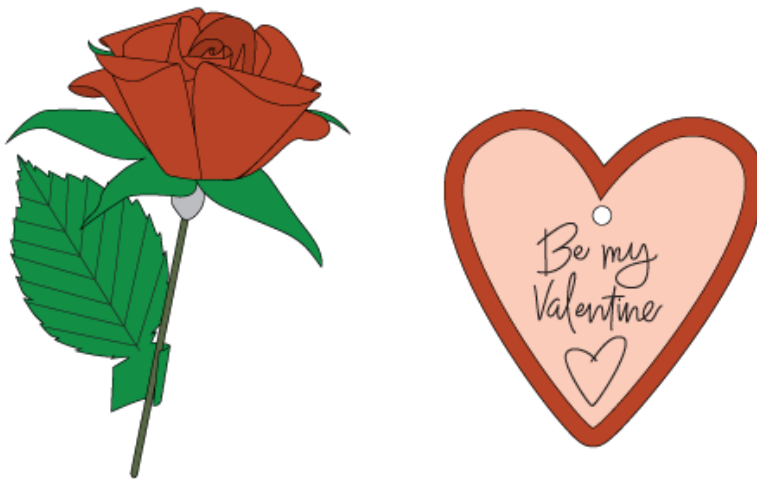


4. Starting with a small petal shape, insert to the wire and glue in place. A small drop of hot glue on the head of the wire will help to fix the stem with the flower layer. Wrap the petals and glue in place.

5. Insert the remaining layers, shape and glue in place.



6. Insert the green sepal and glue it at the bottom of the flower using hot glue. Put some extra glue to secure all in place.
7. Glue the leaf to the stem.
8. Use the green floral tape to cover the stem. Wrap it around the stem, starting at the top.
9. Heart Hang Tag: Put adhesive to the back of the smaller heart and attach to the larger one, lining up the hole.



10. Cut a piece of ribbon, approximately 11" (28cm) long. Tie it around the stem. Insert the hang tag, then tie a bow.
