

Rainbow Heart Box



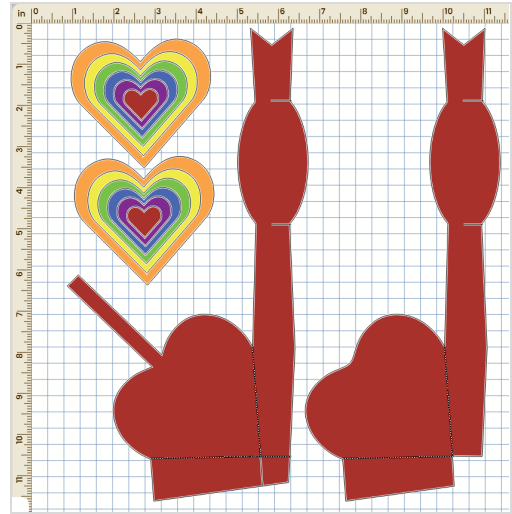
Express your feelings for someone special with this decorative box, created using heart shapes cut from multiple colors of cardstock. Use it as a way to package a small gift, or use the box as a gift all by itself! This project is a great way to use up leftover bits of cardstock when cutting the smaller heart shapes. The finished size of the box is approximately 3½" x 4" x 1¼" (9cm x 10cm x 3cm).

What you need

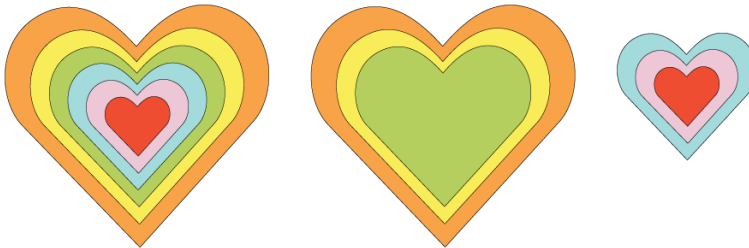
- Cardstock (Red)
- Scraps of Cardstock (orange, yellow green, blue, purple)
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tip (for scoring)
- Scraper
- Adhesive
- Double-sided Non-permanent Tape

Directions

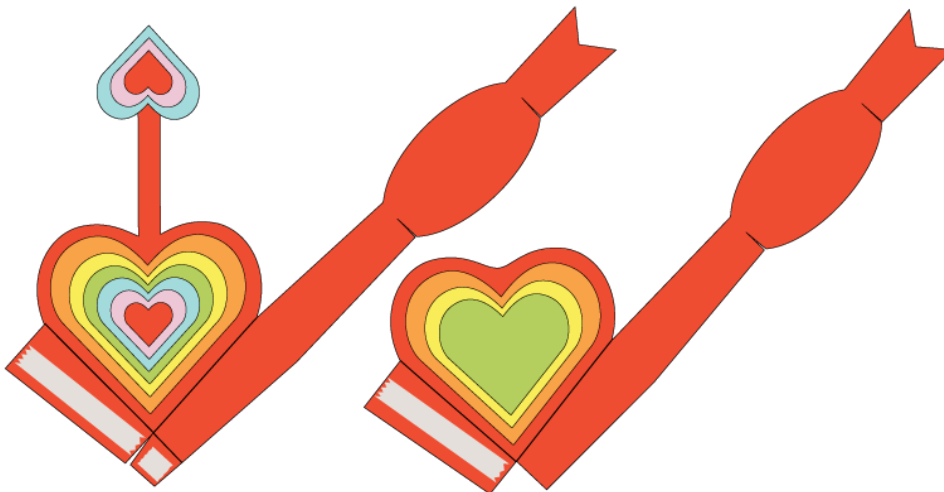
1. Open the project in Canvas. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your mat and follow the steps to score and cut the material on your crafting machine.



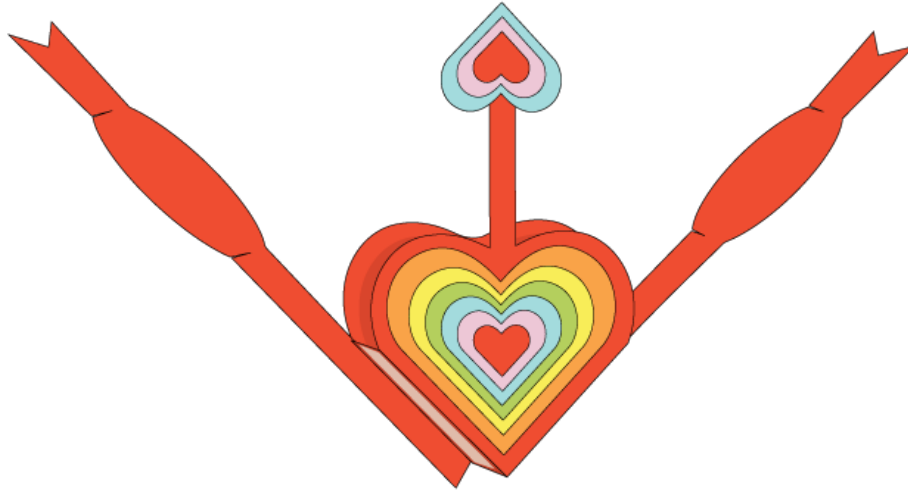
2. Arrange and glue the hearts together by size – all six layers for one side and 3+3 for the other side.



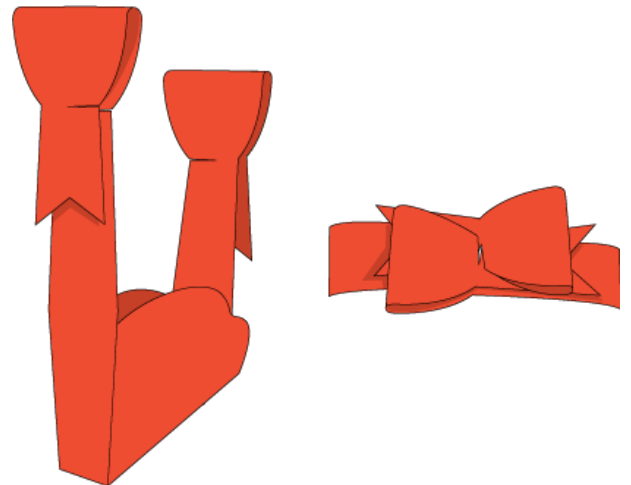
3. Fold the red box pieces along the scoring lines. Use a scraper to make the folds sharp.
4. Glue the hearts to the box as shown below.



5. Apply adhesive on the side panels and the small bottom flap. Fold the bottom flap inside the box and attach it to the inside of the side panel. Put the two pieces together with the shorter side panels on the inside of the box. Press the sides together and let the adhesive dry.



6. Now it is time to put a gift in the box or fill it with treats.
7. To make the bow, fold back the bow pieces and line up the scores.



8. Add double-sided non-permanent tape to the small hearts. Fold over and close the box.
