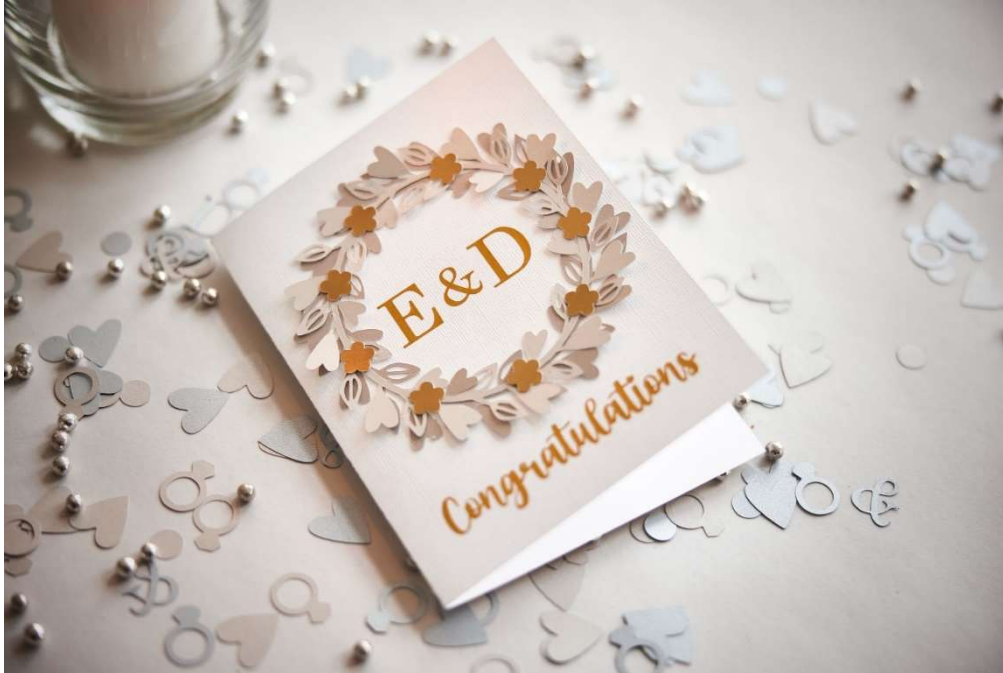


# Monogrammed Congrats Card



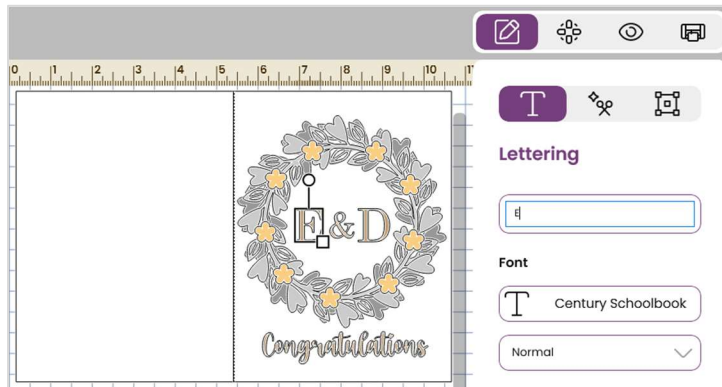
The face of this elegant “congratulations” card features a ring of three-dimensional floral and leaf embellishments. The monogram within the center of the ring is also editable and customizable. The finished size of the card is approximately 5" x 7" (13cm x 18cm).

## What you need

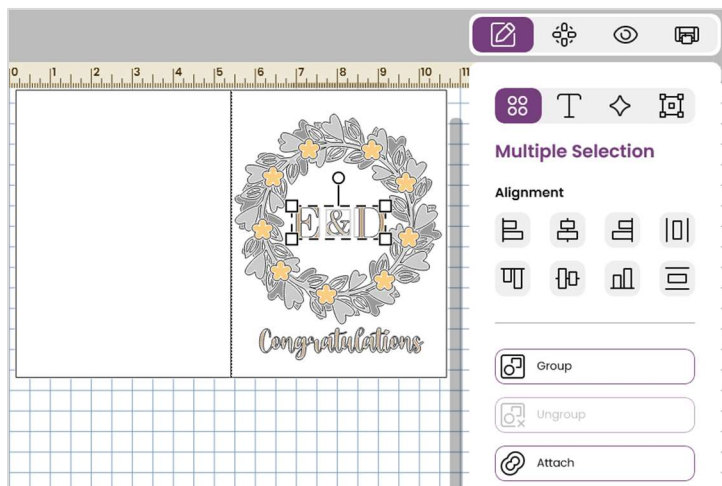
- Medium Glossy Cardstock (White)
- Shimmer Cardstock (two shades of silver)
- Metallic Cardstock (Gold)
- Metallic Vinyl (Gold)
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Standard Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tool (for scoring)
- Scraper
- Weeding Tool
- Adhesive

# Directions

1. Open the project in Canvas.
2. Select the first Letter and in the Edit menu, type in the letter you like. Then do the same to change the second letter.



3. Select the characters (the letters and the ampersand) and click Attach.
4. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your Light Grip Mat. Follow the steps to score and cut the paper on your crafting machine.



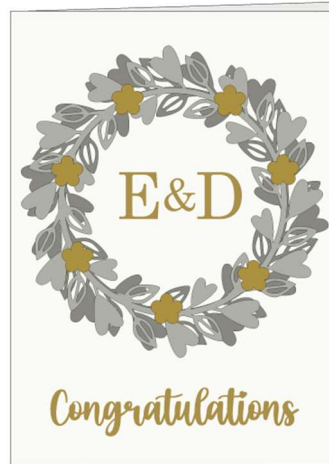
*Note: When using more than one material, check all settings and customize inputs for your mat size, material type, material size, and arrangement of pieces before selecting next to begin cutting each layer.*

5. Place the vinyl on your Standard Grip Mat and follow the steps to cut the vinyl on your crafting machine. To save material, select Rearrange to reduce waste.
6. Fold the card along the scoring line. Use the scraper tool to flatten the fold.
7. Use a Weeding Tool to weed the vinyl and remove the negative bits. Separate the monogram and "Congratulations". Cut pieces of Transfer Tape slightly larger than the designs. Peel off the backing paper from the Transfer Tape and place it over the vinyl designs. Use the Scraper Tool to burnish it into the vinyl. Peel the vinyl liner away from the Tape and the design, making sure all vinyl is transferred to the Transfer Tape.

- Place the vinyl designs on the card front. Use the cut out paper wreath to help position the monogram and the text. Use a Scraper Tool to apply the vinyl to the card. Gently peel off the Transfer Tape.



- Use paper adhesive to glue the wreaths and flowers to the card. The wreath leaves on both layers should go the same direction when placed.
