

Birthday Cupcake Card



A card shaped like a cupcake almost looks good enough to eat! The number on the top layer of the card is editable so you can customize the card as needed. This project offers a great way to use up small leftover bits of cardstock from other projects, too. The finished size of the card is approximately $4\frac{34}{7} \times 7$ " (12cm x 18cm).

What you need

- Medium Cardstock (Purple)
- Medium Cardstock (White)
- Scraps of Cardstock in Five different colors (Pink, light blue, light green, yellow, red)
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tool (for scoring)
- Dual Tip Marker
- Scraper
- Adhesive

Directions

1. Open the project in Canvas. Select the number layer, "1". In the Edit Menu, type in the number of your choice. Adjust the size if necessary.



- 2. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your Light Grip Mat. Follow the steps to score, draw and cut the cardstock and on your crafting machine. Remember to select Rearrange to reduce waste.
- 3. Fold the card along the scoring line. Use the scraper tool to flatten the fold.
- 4. Apply adhesive to the back of the cupcake liner cardstock piece and glue in place. Then add the frosting layer. Put a small amount of adhesive on the back of the small sprinkle pieces, the candle and flame, banner and number and arrange on the card front.
