

Personalized Birthday Card



This festive birthday greeting features a customizable "banner", so you can personalize the card as desired. The balloon embellishments offer a way for you to use up small leftover bits of cardstock from other projects, too! The finished size of the card is approximately 5" x 7" (13cm x 18cm).

What you need

- Medium Cardstock (Beige)
- Light or Medium Cardstock (Blue)
- Light or Medium Cardstock (White)
- Scraps of Cardstock in four different colors (Yellow, purple, green, pink)
- Adhesive Vinyl (Black)
- Adhesive Vinyl (Blue)
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Standard Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tool (for scoring)

- Dual tip Marker (Black)
- Scraper
- Weeding Tool
- Adhesive

Directions

- 1. Open the project in Canvas.
- 2. Select the name layer. In the Edit Menu, type the name you want to have on your card. Adjust the size and spacing if needed.



3. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your Light Grip Mat. Follow the steps to score, draw and cut the paper on your crafting machine.


Note: When using more than one material, check all settings and customize inputs for your mat size, material type, material size, and arrangement of pieces before selecting next to begin cutting each layer.


- 4. Place the vinyl on your Standard Grip Mat and follow the steps to cut the vinyl on your crafting machine.
- 5. Use a Weeding Tool to weed the vinyl and remove the negative bits. Cut pieces of Transfer Tape slightly larger than the designs. Peel off the backing paper from the Transfer Tape and place it over the vinyl designs. Use the Scraper Tool to burnish it onto the vinyl. Peel the vinyl liner away from the Tape and the design, making sure all vinyl is transferred to the Transfer Tape.

- 6. Place the "Happy Birthday" vinyl design on the blue rectangle, on top of the drawn balloon strings as shown. Use the other elements to help position the text. Use a Scraper Tool to apply the vinyl to the card. Gently peel off the Transfer Tape.
- 7. Apply the vinyl name layer to the banner using Transfer Tape.



- 8. Fold the card along the scoring line. Use the Scraper Tool to flatten the fold.
- 9. Apply adhesive to the back of the blue rectangle piece and position on the card front.
- 10. Align the white cloud layer, top and left side, with the blue rectangle.
- 11. Arrange and glue the balloons and the name banner to the card.
