

Cookie Monster Card



Create a fun, interactive card – perfect for your next cookie sale! The monster's mouth has a cut out that allows you to insert a "cookie"! The text on the front of the card is editable, so you can customize it for your event or for the recipient. The finished size of the card is approximately $5" \times 7"$ (13cm x 18cm).


What you need

- Medium Cardstock (White)
- Light or Medium Cardstock (Blue and Dark blue)
- Light or Medium Cardstock (Black, Grey and Brown)
- Adhesive Vinyl (Black)
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Standard Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tip (for scoring)
- Scraper
- Weeding Tool
- Adhesive

Directions

- 1. Open the project in Canvas.
- Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock on your Light Grip Mat. Follow the steps to score and cut the cardstock on your crafting machine. Remember to Rearrange to reduce waste.


Note: When using more than one material, check all settings and customize inputs for your mat size, material type, material size, and arrangement of pieces before selecting next to begin cutting each layer.




- 3. Place the vinyl on your Standard Grip Mat and follow the steps to cut the vinyl on your crafting machine.
- 4. Use a Weeding Tool to weed the vinyl and remove the negative bits. Cut a piece of Transfer Tape slightly larger than the design. Peel off the backing paper from the Transfer Tape and place it over the vinyl designs. Use the Scraper Tool to burnish it onto the vinyl. Peel the liner away from the Tape and the design, making sure all vinyl is transferred to the Transfer Tape.
- 5. Fold the card along the scoring line. Use the scraper tool to flatten the fold.
- 6. Place the vinyl design on the card front. Use a Scraper Tool to apply the vinyl to the card. Gently peel off the Transfer Tape.




7. Apply adhesive to the back of the black mouthpiece and position it on the blue head shape, lining up the cut notches.



8. Apply adhesive around the edge of the blue head piece and adhere it to the dark blue head.



9. Glue the eyes in place, starting with the gray layer, then white and black.



10. Feed the monster a cookie!
