

Cookie Box with Monster Sticker



Who wants a cookie? Everyone! This cookie box is a fun way to share all kinds of sweet treats with friends and family. It's also perfect for school cookie sales and bake sales. The finished size of the box is approximately $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (9cm x 9cm x 4cm). Projects include the Cookie monster image and instructions to create stickers.


What you need

- Medium Cardstock (White)
- Medium Cardstock (Blue)
- Clear Acetate Sheet
- Printable Sticker Paper
- Printer
- Light Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Standard Grip Mat 12" x 12"
- Basic Blade
- Fine Debossing Tool (for scoring)
- Scraper


Directions

- 1. Open the project in Canvas.
- Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Place the cardstock, wrong side up on your Light Grip Mat. Follow the steps to score and cut the cardstock on your crafting machine.




Note: When using more than one material, check all settings and customize inputs for your mat size, material type, material size, and arrangement of pieces before selecting next to begin cutting each layer.


- 3. Place the acetate sheet on your Standard Grip Mat and follow the steps to cut the material on your crafting machine. You should only cut the three first layers: box lid, box base and transparent square. Then you make the sticker.
- 4. To make the sticker: Select the box pieces you already have cut and delete them from the Canvas, leaving only the Cookie monster.
- Select the Cookie monster layer. In the Edit Menu, change the Path Type from Cut to Print.



6. Under Group click to Add Border and set the Margin to 0.08" (2mm).




- 7. In the Multiply Menu, Multiply Tiles and set the Horizontal Repeat to 3, Size 2.2" (55mm) and the Vertical repeat to 4, Size 2.2" (55mm), then click Apply.
- 8. Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Set the Material size to match the size of your printable sticker paper, Letter Portrait or A4 Portrait. Follow the steps to print the designs on the sticker paper using your printer.




Place the printed sticker paper on your Light Grip Mat. Follow the steps to cut around the designs on your crafting machine.




10. Pre-fold the box pieces along the horizontal and vertical score lines. Use the scraper tool to make the folds sharp.



11. On the inside of the lid piece, glue the clear acetate square to cover the cut-out hole.



12. To fold the box: Apply adhesive to section A. Fold the corner triangles B towards section A. Fold down section C and press. Repeat clockwise to fold the other sides.



- 13. Fold the lid piece the same way.
- 14. Decorate the lid with a sticker and put a cookie inside the box!
